An indenture of feoffment between John Joyner of the one part and Thomas Turner junr of the other part was acknowledged by the said John and ordered to be recorded

An inventory and appraisement of the estate of Joseph Williamson dead was returned and ordered to be recorded

Ann Gardner now appearing by virtue of a recognizance entered into before Peter Butte by whom she was bound over as a person of lewd life and conversation and being examined by the court concerning the same and the said Ann Gardner being heard in her own defence It is the opinion of the court that the said Ann Gardner find security for her good behaviour by the space of twelve kalender months that is to say herself in forty pounds and her security in twenty pounds And on failure thereof that she be committed until she find such security

Ordered that the churchwardens bind out Peggy a mulatto child of Ann Gardner according to law
