Ordered that the sheriff summon twenty four of the most capable persons
of this county not being ordinary keepers constables surveyors of highways or
owners or occupiers of mills to appear here on the second Thursday in May next
and be sworn a grand jury of inquest on the body of this county

Persuant to Law the Court doth set the rates of liquors for which
the ordinary keepers in this county are to sell by as last year's purple
corn @ 4^d 0^d gallon
