

An indenture of feoffment between Benjamin Wood of the one part and Joshua Wood of the other part was acknowledged by the said Benjamin and ordered to be recorded.

An indenture of feoffment between Henry Browne and his wife of the one part and Benjamin Ruffin of the other part the receipt thereon endorsed were proved by the oaths of Miles Gony John Thompson and Robert Piespas the witnesses thereto and together with the commission annexed for taking the acknowledgment sworn examination of the within named Hannah and a certificate of the execution thereof are ordered to be recorded.

Ordered that Ninajah Edwards Henry Thomas Joseph Webb and George Gurley jur or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Richard Vick deceased and return the appraisement to the court.

An indenture of feoffment between William Barnes of the one part and Joseph Warren of the other part and the receipt thereon endorsed were proved by the oaths of Howell Edwards Henry Vaughan and John Johnson the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded.

On the Motion of Eleanor Jones who made oath according to law certificate is granted her for obtaining letters of administration on John Jones's estate giving security whereupon the said Eleanor together with Joshua Dargen and Arthur Long her securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of £5000. . . . for the said Eleanor due and faithful admin on the said deceased's estate.

An indenture of feoffment between James Story and Ann his wife of the one part and Samuel Story of the other part and the memorandum of livery of seisen thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the said James and Ann Jones being first privately examined as the law directs and ordered to be recorded.
