Ordered that Peter Butts Benjamin Clements and Charles Simmons do let the repairs or rebuilding of Simmons bridge as they shall think fit and make report thereof to the court

The Sheriff this court made payment of 9457¹/₂ of tobacco in part of 20000⁰ levied for the use of the county Ordered that the Sheriff sell the same at public auction for ready money and account with the court for the sales

Elizabeth the wife of William Hoof personally appeared in court and being first duly examined as the Law directs voluntarily relinquished her right of dower in the estate conveyed by a certain indenture heretofore acknowledged and recorded in this court between the said William Hoof of the one part and Major Tiller of the other part which is ordered to be recorded

On the Motion of John Peterson a witness for Moses Hooper against Thomas Moore It is Ordered that the said Moses pay him five hundred and seventy pounds of sweet tobacco for six days attendance on this court and traveling twenty eight miles five times and returning according to Law

An inventory and appraisement of the estate of Conrad Chubbys deceased was returned and ordered to be recorded

An indenture of Coffment between Japse Washington of the one part and Benjamin Butler of the other part and the memorandum of seven thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the said Japse and Butler to be recorded
