two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded and on the
motion of the said executor who made oath according to
law certificate is granted her for obtaining a probat thereof in
due form giving security whereupon the said executor together
with Joseph Joyner John Joyner and Joshua Whitney his security
entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of
£1000 for the said executor due and faithful administration
on the said decedent's estate and performance of his will.

Ordered that Bennett Hilman Job Wright Henry Joyner
and John Joyner or any three of them being sworn before a justice
of the peace do appraise in current money the slaves if any
and personal estate of William Joyner dec'd and return the
appraisement to the court.

The last will and testament of Catherine Dunkley dec'd
was presented in court by Thomas Joyner Matthew Joyner
and John Boykin the executors therein named proved by
the oaths of Richard Stello and Edward Doyle two of the witnesses
thereto and ordered to be recorded And on the motion of the said
executors who made oath according to law certificate is granted
them for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security
whereupon the said executors together with Samuel Blount
and Edmund Tyler their securities entered into and acknowledged
their bond in the penalty of £2000 for the said executors due
and faithful admin on the said decedent's estate & performance
of his will.

Ordered that Sampson Pitman Edmund Tyler Joseph Moxey
and John Wellens or any three of them being first sworn before a justice
of the peace do appraise in current money the slaves if any and
personal estate of Catherine Dunkley dec'd and return the appraisement
to the court.
