This cause came on this day to be heard on the bill answer the depositions taken and returned & the arguments of the council on both sides whereupon the council for the defendant moved that the deposition of Arthur Williamson might not be read in evidence in this cause alleging that the said Arthur was interested in the cause thereof which motion was opposed by the plaintiffs council & overruled by the court And thereupon It is Decreed & Ordered that the injunction prayed for in the complainants bill to stay the proceedings on a certain bill in chancery exhibited in this court by the defendants against the plaintiff Thomas as executor of one Francis Caumbe and also to stay the execution of a judgment at Law in the said court obtained by the defendants against the said plaintiff Thomas be and remain perpetual And It is further Ordered that Joseph Gray Richard Wells Daniel Fisher & Samuel Blon gent or any three of them do state and settle an account of the estate of Mary Caumbe deced according to the several agreements in the bill mentioned and that they make report thereof in order to a final decree From which decree the defendant prayed an appeal to the next general court which was denied by the court untill a final decree be given herein

Upon the petition of Isham Gilliam agt Samuel Sebrall for one pound five shillings and eleven pence by account This day came the parties who being fully heard It is Considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the said one pound five shillings & eleven pence & his costs by him in this behalf expended

On the Motion of Daniel Sebrall a witness for Isham Gilliam agt Samuel Sebrall It is Ordered that the said Isham pay him ten pounds of new tobacco for one days attendance on this court
