

In the petition of Richard Vick for leave to erect a water grist mill on the Lifford
swamp, it is ordered that the sheriff summon a jury of twelve freeholders of the
vicinage who being first duly sworn before a justice of the peace or the sheriff
shall diligently examine & view the lands that may be affected or laid under
water by reason of building such mill together with the timber & other conveniences
thereon that they report under their hands and seals the true value of the
damages to the party holding such lands or to any other person or persons.

and his costs by him about his suit in this behalf expended and the said
defendant in mercy &c. But this Judgment except as to the costs is to be discharged
by the payment of five pounds sixteen shillings & eleven pence & Interest
to be computed after the rate of five p^{er} Centum p^{er} Annum from the 29th
of September 1768 till paid
