Peter a negro boy & Peter a negro girl belonging to Hon^{ble} Edmunds are by the court adjudged the P. Peter to ten Years of age (the S. Peter to Eleven Years of age)

An Indenture of feoffment between Reuben Cook of the one part and Peter Hines of the other part & a mem^o of livery of seisin thereon were acknowledged by the said Cook & ordered to be recorded & Mary the wife of the said Reuben being first privily examined as the law directs voluntarily relinquished her right of dower in the lands conveyed thereby
