Orders that John Benson, John Wilkinson, William Benson & Henry Caffie do audit state and settle and account court of John Jones estate & make report thereof to the next Court.

A jury of the Jury about a mill petition for by Richard Vick was this day returned in these words (to wit) We of the Jury being first sworn have diligently viewed an acre of land opposite to a mill built by Rich Vick & the lands adjacent thereto which may be affected or laid under water by building such mill together with the timber & other conveniences thereon to five shillings curr^t money. Jeremiah Ellis, Geo. Gurley, Jr. Drake, Nathan Vaper Jr. Edward Tho^r Crenshaw, Benj Pope, Wm Pope Jr. Pope Tho^r Edward, Tho^r Barnes, Ephraim & Williams. Whereupon it is ordered that the said acre of land Petition for be granted to the said Vick and that he have leave to erect the said mill paying the damages in the report mentioned.

A report of the jury about a mill petition for by Horace Edmund was this day returned in these words (to wit) "We of the Jury being duly sworn have diligently examined & valued an acre of land opposite to a mill intended to be built by Horace Edmund & the lands adjacent thereto which may be affected or laid under water by building such mill together with the timber & other conveniences thereon to twenty five shillings curr^t money. Henry Taylor, Thos. Hart Joseph Warren, Henry Vaughan, Joseph Delt, Stephen Pope, Isaac Johnson, Robt Biddle, Sam Kinsland, Arthur Pope, Simon Turner, Tho^r Porter" Whereupon it is ordered that the said acre Petition for be granted to the said Edmund & that he have leave to erect the said mill paying the damages in the afores^d report mentioned.
