 & ordered to be recorded And on the motion of the said Executor who  
 made oath according to Law certificate was granted him for  
 obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security whereupon  
 the said Moses with William Taylor and Barnaby Bailey his  
 securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of  
 One thousand pounds for the said Moses due & faithful adminis-  
 tration on the estate of the said decedent & performance of his will

Ordered that William Bailey Charles Calthorpe William (DeLoach &  
 Kinehen Taylor or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of  
 the peace do appraise in current money the flar is (if any) & personal  
 estate of Robert Booth & return the appraisement to the next  
 Court

On the motion of Elizabeth Bonnell who made oath according to Law  
 certificate is granted her for obtaining letters of administration  
 on the estate of Joseph Bonnell giving security whereupon the J<sup>ud</sup> directed  
 together with Simon Baykin & J<sup>ud</sup> Taylor enters into & acknowledges their bond in  
 the penalty of two thousand pounds for the J<sup>ud</sup> & due & faithful adminis-  
 tration on the estate of the said decedent & performance of his will
