been given to William Drake Esq; of the said Thomas according to the act  
of Assembly in that case made & provided Whereupon the said David  
Hines and Joshua Hines were examined of their depositions ordered  
to be lodged in the office till next Court

Ordered that the churchwardens bind out Britain & Charles Travis according  
to Law

An Indenture of Leffment between George Gurley sen. of the one part &  
George Gurley Jr. of the other part with a mem. of delivery of seven &  
recusation endorsed now acknowledged by the above named George  
Gurley sen. and ordered to be recorded

An Inventory and appraisement of the estate of Isaac Mason  
was this day returned and ordered to be recorded

Upon the complaint of Thomas Gray Jr. against Benjamin Worrell  
this day for a breach of the peace the parties appeared in Court who  
being heard it is the opinion of the Court that he find security for  
his good behaviour for the space of six months & that he also appear  
at the next Court to be held in May to answer an indictment to  
be exhibited against him by the said Thomas Gray Jr. Whereupon  
the said Benjamin with John Bowing and James Kitchen his securities,  
came into Court and acknowledged themselves generally indebted to  
our sovereign lord king George third in the sum of £ 20 each to be  
lived of their respective lands and tenements goods and chattels  
and to our lord the King & his heirs and successors rendered Yet upon  
this condition that if the said Benjamin shall be of good behaviour  
towards all his liege people & more especially towards  
the said Thomas Gray Jr. for the space of six months next  
he shall appear at the next court to be held in May to answer the  
aforesd. Indictm. & not depart hence without leave of the Court  
then this recognizance to be void

Upon the complaint of Thomas Gray the clear against Nathan  
Worrell for a breach of the peace this day came the parties who  
being heard Ordered that the said Worrell appear at the next Court  
to be held in May to answer an Indictm. to be exhibited agst him by the said Gray
