witnesses thence and ordered to be recorded

An Indenture of feoffment between Geo. Wood of the one part and
Joshua Wood of the other part & a num^r of livery of seisen thereon
endorsed were acknowledged by the s^d Geo. Wood & ordered to be
recorded

On the motion of Edward Baile who made oath according to Law
certificate was granted him for attaining letters of administration
on the estate of Richard Hazlewood ^{deceased} giving security whereupon
the said Edward with Charles Cosby his security entered into and
acknowledged their bond in the penalty of five hundred pounds
for the s^d Bailes due and faithful administration on the estate of
the s^d deceased

Orders that John Clayton John Harris Matthew Harris & William Bayless
or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the Peace
do appraise in current money the slaves (if any) and personal estate
of Rich^d Hazlewood deceased and return the appraisement to the next
Court
