and Elisha Crocker who being elected tried and sworn the truth to speak
upon the issue joins upon their oath do say that the defendant did
assume upon himself in manner and form as the plaintiff against them
hath alleged and they do assess the plaintiffs damages by occasion thereof
to James Peunes five shillings and five pence & his costs by him about
his suit in this behalf expenses and the *Defend.* in Mercy & therefore
it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the *Defend.*
his damages above in form above assessed

An Indenture of feoffment between David Bunn of the one part & J^{es}
Council of the other part & a num^r of livery of seisin thereon endorsed
was acknowledged by the said David Bunn ordered to be recorded
And Patience the wife of the said Bunn personally appeared in Court
and being first privily examined as the Law directs voluntarily
relinquished her right of dower in the estate conveyed by the *Indenture*

Present Joseph Gray present Nicholas Maget *Jent.*

On the motion of Joseph Gray who made oath according to Law Certificate
is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of James
Macy giving security whereupon the said Joseph with Henry Taylor
his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of
One hundred pounds for the said Josephs due and faithful administration
on the estate of the said decedent

Ordered that Charles Simmons Benjamin Clements the elder Benjamin Clements
the Younger & William Annew or any three of them being first sworn
before a justice of the Peace do appraise in current money the slaves
if any and personal estate of James Macy and return the appraisement
to the next Court
