

A Court held for the County of Southampton the 9<sup>th</sup> day of May 1760

An Indenture of feoffment between George Jordan and Patience his wife of the one part and Honable Branch of the other part and a receipt thereon endorsed were first acknowledged by the said George Jordan and Patience his wife the being first privately examined as the Law directs & ordered to be recorded

An Indenture of feoffment between John Smith of the one part & Samuel Bailey of the other part and a mem<sup>o</sup> of livery of seisin thereon endorsed were proved by the solemn affirmation of Anselm Bailey Anselm Bailey jr and Charles Thomson (they being of the People called Quakers) the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded

An Indenture of feoffment between Charles Willons of the one part And John Willons jr of the other part and a mem<sup>o</sup> of livery of seisin thereon endorsed were first acknowledged by the within named Charles Willons and ordered to be recorded And Sarah the wife of the said Charles personally appears in Court and being first privately examined as the Law directs voluntarily relinquished her right of dower in the lands conveyed by this indenture

An Indenture of feoffment between John Woolen of the one part and Linchen Taylor of the other part and a receipt thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the said John Woolen and ordered to be recorded And Barbara the wife of the said John personally appears in Court and being first privately examined as the Law directs voluntarily relinquished her right of dower in the lands conveyed by this indenture

An account current of the estate of William Sandeford was this day reported and ordered to be recorded

Ordered that William Haynes Thomas Gray Benjamin Denson Joseph Denson or any three of them do examine state and settle Hodges Councils account of his administration on the estate of Henry Pope dec<sup>d</sup> & make report thereof to the Court

An account current of John Jones estate was this day reported by the persons appointed to settle the same and ordered to be recorded

An Indenture of feoffment between William Harris of the one part and Daniel Mackie of the other part was acknowledged by the said Harris and ordered to be recorded
