Benjamin Barham of the other part, and a memorandum of livery
of seisin and receipt thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the said
Joshua Pullon and ordered to be recorded and Ann the wife of the
said Joshua personally appeared in Court and being first privately
examined as the law direct voluntarily relinquished her right of
dower in the estate conveyed by the said indenture

An Indenture of giftment between Thomas Barham of the one part
and Solomon DeLoache of the other part was acknowledged by the said Thomas and ordered to be recorded and
Sarah the wife of the said Thomas personally appeared in Court and being
first privately examined as the law direct voluntarily relinquished her
right of dower in the estate conveyed by the said indenture

An Indenture of giftment between Benjamin Barham of the one part &
Nathan Newsum of the other part and a receipt thereon endorsed were
acknowledged by the said Benjamin Barham and ordered to be recorded &
Mary the wife of the said Barham personally appeared in court & being
first privately examined as the Law direct voluntarily relinquished her
right of dower in the estate conveyed by this indenture
