Timothy Thorpe his security entered into and acknowledged their bond
in the penalty of two thousand pounds for the f. executors due
and faithful Administration on the estate of the f. decedent &
performance of his will

Ordered that Thomas Holt Christopher Foster David Newsum & Jacob
Newsum or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the
peace do appraise in current money the slaves if any & personal
estate of Robert Barham & return the appraisement to the next
Court

An Indenture of feoffment between Richard Williams and Lydia his
wife of the one part and Francis Bracy of the other part and a
memorandum of livery of seisin thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the f.
Richard Williams and Lydia his wife she being first privately exa-
mined as the law directs and ordered to be recorded

A report concerning Buckhorn was this day returned in the words
following

Ordered that the treasurer pay Joseph Belk three pounds five
shillings for the repairs of Buckhorn Bridge

Richard Vick is by the court appointed surveyor of the highway
in the room of William Vick who is discharged

Augustine Davis is by the court appointed guardian to Augustine
Cyrus and Archilles Davis orphans of Gideon Davis Whereupon
the said Augustine Davis with Robert Watkins entered into
and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of five hundred
pounds for securing the said orphans estate and
indemnifying the Court
