out of the heart of Cypress the joist to be 10 by 12 got out of cypress
or old pine 5 joists to each arch the plank 2 1/4 inches thick out of
the heart of Cypress or good old pine without sap to be nailed in
the same form of beam water bridge and to be 12 feet in the clear the
tenants to the mud pits 4 inches thick 6 inches long in the plates
3 inches thick & 5 inches long to be completed in a workmanlike
manner One foot higher than the old bridge by the 25th day of
December 17th J. Edmunds H. Edwards Rob. Bicks Henry Thomas
which is ordered to be recorded
