vately examin'd as the law directs and Order'd to be
recorded

Order'd that the Treasurer of this county pay miles
carry the sum of Five pounds for keeping the Bridge
over nottonway at his house

The alias capias not
being Executed on the motion of the plaintiffs by their attorney
a Pluries Capias awarded against the defendants return'd
to the next court

An Indenture of feoffment between Edward Wright
of the one part and William Grimmer of the other part
was proved by the solemn affirmation of James
Jordan Scott and Joseph Scott they being of the peo-
ple called quakers and the receipt endos'd was pro-
ved by the said James Jordan Scott and on the 11th
day of December 1760 was further proved by the oath
of Samuel Brown witness Thereto and together with
the said Receipt Order'd to be recorded

itant of this county

Upon the petition of George Washington assignee of
John Waller against James for Three pounds ten
shillings due by note This day came the plaintiff by
his attorney and the defendant being duly summoned
