An Indenture of feoffment between Edward Wright
of the one part and William Grinner of the other part

ple called quakers and the receipt endes'd was pro
ved by the said James Jordan Scott and on the 11.
day of December 1760 was further proved by the oath
of Samuel Brown witness thereto and together with
the said Receipt Ordred to be recorded
