On the motion of Amos Thanis who made oath according to law certificat is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Edward Matthews whereupon the said Amos with Ben Lewis his security entered into and acknowledged their Bond in the penalty of five hundred pounds for the due and faithful administration of the decedents estate and performance of his will

Ordered that Timothy Thorpe James Jones Joshua nicholson junior and Joshua claud or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Amos Thanis and return the appraisement to this court

On the motion of Priscilla Newsum who made oath according to law certificat is granted her for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Nathan Newsum whereupon the said Priscilla Newsum with James Ridley Benjamin Lewis and Gregory Rawlings entered into and acknowledged their Bond in the penalty of two thousand pounds for the due and faithful administration on the decedents estate and performance of his will

Ordered that John Gilliam James Jones Henry Westbrooke and Thomas Westbrooke or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Nathan Newsum and return the appraisement to this court

Charles Stowells and Benjamin Traindall being summoned as jurymen and not appearing accordingly they be severally fined accordingly
