The last will and testament of Arthur Williams was this day presented in court by Anne Williams and William Williams the Executors therein named and proved by the oaths of John Wright and by John Brently & by the solemn affirmation of Sam Jordan Scott one of the people called quakers and order'd to be recorded and on the motion of the said Executors who made oath according to law certificate was granted them for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security Whereupon the said Ann Williams with William Williams James Jordan Scott and John Wright his securitys enter'd into and acknowledg'd their Bond in the penalty of one thousand pounds for the due &
