An Indenture of feoffment from Between Martha Lewis
and James Lewis of the one part and Samuel Peete of
the other part and the receipts thereon endos'd were
proved by the oaths of Miles Cary Joseph Leith and
Thomas Brichette witnesses thereto and order'd to be re-
corded

An Indenture of feoffment between Joshua Vick of
the one part and Natham Vasser of the other part
was acknowledg'd by the said Joshua Vick party
thereto and order'd to be recorded and Elizabeth the
wife of the said Joshua personally appeared in court
being first privately examin'd as the law directs
voluntarily relinquish'd her right of dower in the estate
conveyed by the said Indenture

The last will and testament of Moses Crocker was
this day presented in Court by Mary Crocker one of
the Executors therein named and proved by the oaths
of John Wilkinson and Benjamin Bynum two of
the witnesses thereto and order'd to be recorded
