An Indenture of feoffment between William Bronne and Sarah his wife of the one part and Benjamin Ruffin of the other part and the receipt and Memorandum of livery and seizin thereon indorsed were proved by the oath of Thomas Gray a witness thereto and on the 13th Aug^r 1761 the same were proved by the oath of William Edwards a witness thereto and on the 10th of September 1761 the same was further proved by the oath of William Simmons another of the witnesses thereto and thereupon the said Indenture Memorandum and Receipt together with the Commission annexed for taking the acknowledgement and privy examination of the within named Sarah and a certificate of Execution thereof were ordered to be recorded

The last will and testament of Sam^l Westhooke was proved by the oaths of John Person and Joshua Clarke two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded and on the motion of Hon^{ble} Westhooke and James Ramsey the Executors therein named whamade oath according to law certificate is granted them for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security Whereupon the said Hon^{ble} Westhooke with James Ramsey Sam^l Westhooke and John Person his securities entered into and acknowledged their Bond in the penalty of one thousand pound for the due and faithful administration on the estate of the deceased and performance of his will

Ordered that David Edmudas Thomas Leav Jacob Shawis and Henry Shawis or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current money the slaves if any and a personal estate of Sam^l Westhooke and return the appraisement to this court
