the one part and Abraham Matthews of the other part
was acknowledg'd by the within named Edmund
Banolt and order'd to be recorded and Mary the wife
of the said Edmund personally appeared in court
and being first privately examin'd as the law directs
voluntarily relinquis'd her right of dower in the
estate convey'd by the said Indenture

Benjamin Schell is by the court appointed a Constable
in the room of Thomas Davis who is discharg'd &
the said Schell was accordingly sworn into his said
office

An Account Current of the estate of John Parrell was this
day return'd and order'd to be recorded

Aaron Thorpe is by the court appointed surveyor of the
highway in the room of Jacob Stanis who is discharg'd

William Person is by the court appointed Surveyor of
the highway in the room of John Little who is discharg'd

John Johnson is by the court appointed overseer of the
highway in the room of John Underwood who is dis-
