This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and the defendant being duly summoned and served with a copy of the petition and account and not appearing on the motion of the plaintiff, who proved his demand to be just. It is considered that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the said three pounds three shillings and six pence and his cost by him about his suit, in this behalf expended.

x — Upon the petition of John Ingram against Richard Hamlin for three pounds two shillings and ten pence due by account. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney as well the defendant in his proper person. It is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the aforesaid sum of three pounds two shillings and ten pence and his cost by him in this behalf expended.

— On the motion of Henry Ivy sen.^r the following thynables are ordered to be added to the Henry Ivy list to wit the said Henry Ivy, George Ivy Robt Ivy Gathwhite Ivy and a negro, Cupid & Davy

— An Indenture of feoffment between Henry Applenhaite and Ann his wife of the one part and William Shines of the other part, and the Memorandum of livery of Seign^r thereon made were acknowledged by the within named Henry Applenhaite and Ann his wife she being first privately examined as the law directs and ordered to be recorded.

— Upon the petition of Joseph Scott against Moses Joyner for two pounds three shillings and five pence due by account. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney as also the defendant in his proper person who confessed the allegation of the said petition. Therefore It is considered that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the said three pounds three shillings and five pence & his cost by him in this behalf expended.
