And on the motion of the said Executor who made oath according to law certificate was granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security Whereupon the said William Pope with Hardy Alkinson his security enter'd into and acknowledg'd their Bond in the penalty of Five hundred pounds for the due and faithfull administration on the decedents estate and performance of his will.

Ordin'd that John Edwards Graphoditus Williams Joseph Everett and Lewis Bryants or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Benjamin Pope and return the appraisement to this court.

An Acco^{ts} Cur^{ts} of the estate of Moody Kirby was this day returned and order'd to be recorded.

On the motion of Elizabeth Gurley who made oath according to law certificate was granted her for obtaining Letters of Administration on the estate of Benjamin Gurley dec'd Whereupon the said Elizabeth with George Gurley jun^r enter'd into and acknowledg'd their Bond in the penalty of Two hundred pounds for the due and faithfull administration on the decedents estate.

Ordin'd that Natham Tapper John Drake James Horry and Thomas Edwards or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Benjamin Gurley and return the appraisement to this court.
