An Indenture of seoffment between Richard Parker of the one party and William Andrews of the other party and the receipt whereon endos'd were acknowledged by the within named Richard Parker party thereto and ordered to be recorded.

The last will and testament of Benjamin Pope was this day presented in court by William Pope the Executor therein named proved by the oath of Robert Kirk and Jepse Pope two of the witnesses thereto and said to be recorded. And on the motion of the said Executor who made oath according to law certificate was granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security Whereupon the said William Pope with Hardy Atkinson his security entered into and acknowledged their Bond in the penalty of Five hundred pounds for the due and faithfull administration on the decedents estate and performance of his will.

Ordered that John Edwards Esq; appraides Williams Joseph Everett and Lewis Bryant or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Benjamin Pope and return the appraisement to this court.

An exec'c'nt'c' of the estate of Moody Kirby was this day returned and ordered to be recorded.

On the motion of Elizabeth Gurley who made oath according to law certificate was granted her for obtaining letters of Administration on the estate of Benjamin Gurley dec'd Whereupon the said Elizabeth with George Gurley jun'r entered into & acknowledged their Bond in the penalty of Two hundred pounds for the due and faithfull administration on the decedents estate.

Ordered that Nathan Passe John Drake James and Thomas Edwards or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Benjamin Gurley and return the appraisement to this court.
