urity Whereupon the said John Joyner with William
Joyner and Giles Joyner his security entred into and ack-
nowledg'd their bond in the penalty of one thousand
pounds for the due and faithfull administration of the
decedent's estate and performance of his will

Ordered that Christopher Wade Henry Joyner William
Denson and Matthew Charles or any three of them do
appraise in Current money the slaves if any and per-
sonal estate of Joseph Joyner and return the appraise-
ment to this Court

Gurley Ordid that Micajah Edwards Henry Thomas

part and Lewis Joyner of the other part and the sum
of Lixury and Seuzen and Rec^t thereon endys'd were proved
by the oaths of Joshua Gross John Bradley and by the
solemn affirmation of Joseph Denson being one of the
people called quakers and order'd to be recorded
