Pounds twelve shillings and four pence and his cost by
him about his suit in this behalf expended and the
said defendant in mercy &c.^a But this judgement ex-
cept as to the cost is to be discharg'd by the payment
of Twenty Pounds sixteen shillings & 2 together with
interest from the 1st day of Aug^r 1760 till paid To be
paid when ever affs sufficient are in the hands of the
said defendant after satisfying debts of greater dig-
nity.
