But this judgement except as to the costs is to be dis-  
charged by the payment of Eight pounds thirteen shillings  
and six pence half penny together with interest from the  
11<sup>th</sup> day of Aug<sup>r</sup> 1755 till paid to be discharged when  
assets sufficient are in the hands of the said defendant  
after debts of greater dignity.
