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last will and testament of Thomas Sholliman was this presented in Court by Nathan Sholliman one of the Executors named proved In the oaths of Charles Esby and a va Esby two of the witnesses thereto and ordred to be recorded And on the motion of the said Esby who made oath according to law Certificate Calificati was granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security whereupon the said Nathan Sholliman with Aaron Phelps and John Clark his securitys entred into and acknowledged their Bond in the penalty of one thousand pounds for the due and faithfull administration of the decedents estate and performance of his will

Ordred that Arthur Williamson Ben Williamson Joseph Phillips and Jesse Wombwell or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in Current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Thomas Sholliman and return the Appraisement to this Court

An Indenture of feoffment Between Thomas Francis of the one part and Thomas Law Sen^r of the other part and the Memorandum of Livery and Seisin thereon enclosed were acknowledged by the within named Thomas Francis jun^r and ordred to be recorded And Elizabeth the wife of the said Thomas personally appeared in Court and being first privately examined as the law directs voluntarily relinquish'd her right of dower in the estate conveyed by this Indenture

On the motion of Benjamin Benson who being one of the people called Quakers solemnly affirmed Letters of admton is certificate is granted him for obtaining Letters of admton on the estate of Hodges Council whereupon the said Benjamin Benson with James Jordan Scott and Daniel Fier his securitys entred into and acknowledged their Bond in the penalty of two hundred pounds for the due and faithfull administration on the decedents estate

Ordred that William Sayne Richard Warrell Stande Pope and Matthew Charles or any three of them being first sworn before a Justice of the peace do appraise in Curr money the slaves if any and personal estate of Hodges Council and return the appraisement to this Court

a writing purporting the last will of Joseph Thorpe was this day produced in Court But the witnesses thereto being removed out of the Colony on the motion of John Thorpe the widow and Esby named therein who made oath according to law Certificate was granted her for obtaining Letters of admton with the said writing annifed whereupon the said John Thorpe with Simon Pope and Thomas Crenshaw entred into and acknowledged their Bond in the penalty of one hundred pounds for the due and faithfull administration of the decedents estate
