Ordered that Charles Casby Joseph Monger Sampson Pl^{ff} or Edmund Tyler or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in Curr^t money the slaves if any and personal estate of Edmund Doyle dec'd and return the appraisement to this Court
