Therefore it is considered by the Court that this Attachment be dismissed.

On the motion of Thomas Skolt who made oath according to law certificate was granted him for obtaining a letter of administration on the estate of Jesse Skolt Whereupon the said Thomas with George Rawlings his security entered into and acknowledged his Bond in the penalty of Two hundred pounds for the due and faithful administration on the decedent's estate.

On the motion of John Jenkins sen.^r a witness for Daniel Fisher ag^t Bradshaw Order'd that the said Daniel pay him one hundred and seventy six pounds of Tobacco for travelling twenty one Miles twice and two days attendance on this Court according to law.

Order'd that Edmund Tyler be appointed overseer in the room of John Matthews deceased.

A Report concerning a Road from Mial Atkinsons to the County line returned this day in the words following

"In Obedience to an order of Southampton Court bearing date 11th March 1762 We the Subscribers have viewed the lands whereon a road is proposed to be cleared from Mial Atkinsons on Blunt's Swamp to the County line and opening the said road agreeable to the Courses after mentioned will not prejudice any person
