vs Berman Esq^r } By Consent of the parties all matters in difference in this cause are referred to the arbitration & determination of William Simmons Benjamin Simmons & Thomas Moore or any two of them and their award to be the judgement of this Court.

On the motion of Nicholas Magel who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining Letters of Admorton on the estate of Joseph Morton dec'd Whereupon the said Nicholas Magel and David Edmunds his securitys entered into and acknowledged their Bonds in the penalty of Fifty pounds for the due and faithfull administration on the decedents estate.

Ordid that Jacob Simmons John Withinson Benjamin Bynum and Nath^l Bryant or any three of them do appraise in Current money (being first sworn before a Justice of the peace) the slaves if any and personal estate of Joseph Morton and return the appraisement to this Court.

The Executors of vs Person Esq^r } By Consent of the parties all matters in difference in this cause are referred to the determination of Stowell Edmunds James Ridley and Henry Taylor Gent^l and their award to be the decree of this Court.

The last will and testament of Thomas Banow was presented in Court by Richard Avery and Joseph Phillips two of the Executors therein named proved by the oaths of David Edmunds the witnesses thereto and ordid to be recorded And on the motion of the said Executor who made oath according to law certificate was granted them (the other executors refusing to join in the probat) for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security &c Whereupon the said Executors with David Edmunds and Thomas Davis their securitys entered into and acknowledged their Bond in the penalty of one thousand pounds for the due and faithfull administration of the decedents estate and performance of his will.
