The last will and testament of Joshua Whitney was this day presented in Court by Margaret Whitney The Executor therein named and proved by the oaths of Charles Lawrence and Mary Bland two of the witnesses thereto & ordered to be recorded and on the motion of the said Executor who made oath according to law certificate was granted her for obtaining a probat in due form giving security whereupon the said Margaret Whitney with John Joyner Lewis Joyner and Charles Lawrence herse cunity entered into and acknowledged their Bond in the penalty of Five hundred Pounds for the due and faithful administration on the decedents estate & performance of his will.

The last will and testament of Joshua Barnes was this day presented in Court by Brittain Barnes and Benjamin Barnes the Executors therein named and proved by the oaths of Job Wright and Sarah Obery and by the solemn affirmation of James Jordan Scott one of the people called quakers) and ordered to be recorded and on the motion of the aforesaid executors who made oath according to law certificate is granted them for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security &c. Whereupon the said Brittain Barnes and Ben^y Barnes with William Drenn & John Beal their securitys entered into and acknowledged their Bond in the penalty of Two hundred Pounds for the due and faithful admton on the decedents estate and performance of his will.

Ordered that Thomas Obery Ben^y Williams Barnaby Drake and Standy Johnson or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in Current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Joshua Barnes & return the appraisement to this Court.

An Indenture of feoffment betwixen William Jones of the one part and Thomas Tynes of the other part and the memorandum of livery and seizin thereon enclosed were acknowledged by the within named William Jones party thereto and ordered to be recorded and Elizabeth the wife of the said William personally appeared in Court being first privately examined as the law directs voluntarily relinquished her right of dower in the estate conveyed thereby.
