Also that the Court doth value the said Scipio to seventy
five pounds

On the motion of Abrighton Jones a witness on the above trial for
our Sovereign Lord the King, orderd that the said Jones be paid
Fifty pounds of Tobacco for two days attendance on this Court
according to law

On the motion of John Skines & Robert Scarborough witnesses
for our Sovereign Lord the King, orderd that they be severally
paid seventy five pounds of Tob.^o for three days attendance
on this Court according to law
