

in his proper person who confessed the plaintiffs action for six pounds seventeen shillings and eight pence the debt in the declaration mention'd. Therefore this court is of the opinion that the p^l recover agst the said def^t the said six pounds seventeen shillings and eight pence and his costs by him about his suit in this behalf expended and these defendant in mercy &c. But this judge except as to the costs is to be discharged by the payment of three pounds eighteen shillings and eight pence together with interest from the 16th day of March 1762 till paid.

upon the petition of Benjamin Denson agst Arthur Bradshaw for four pounds two shillings and two pence due by note this day came the p^l by his atty and the defendant being duly summoned and served with a copy of the petition and acc^d and not appearing on the motion of the p^l by his atty. It is considered by the Court that the p^l recover agst the s^d def^t the s^d four pounds two shillings and two pence and his costs by him in this behalf expended. But this judgement except as to the costs is to be discharged by the payment of four pounds one shilling and one penny together with interest from the tenth day of June one thousand seven hundred & sixty two till paid.

upon the petition Simon Jones agst Baker White for three pounds fifteen due by note of hand. This day came the p^l by his attorney and the def^t being duly summoned and served with a copy of the petition and not appearing on the motion of the said p^l by his attorney. It is considered by the Court that the p^l recover agst the said def^t three pounds and his costs by him in this behalf expended together with interest from the 25th day of Dec^r 1761 till paid.

On the motion of Elizabeth Bynum who made oath according to law certificate is granted her for obtaining Letters of Administration on the estate of William Bynum dec^d. And the said Elizabeth with Benjamin Bynum and John Withinson her securities entered into and acknowledged their Bonds in the penalty of one thousand pounds for the due and faithful administration of the decedent's estate.

Ordered that Cordat & reflect Jacob Simmons John Edwards and Joseph Everett or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in law money the slaves if any and personal estate of William Bynum dec^d and return the appraisement to this Court.
