Lewis Henry Johnson John Kirby Jacob Simon Henry Applewhaite and Joseph Everett who being elected tryed and sworn the truth to speak upon the issue joind upon their oath do say that the defendant did assume upon himself in manner and form as the plaintiff agst him hath declared and they do assess the plaintiffs damages by occasion thereof to eleven pounds sixteen shillings and four pence besides his costs Therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover agst the said defendant his damages aforesaid in form aforesaid assayed his costs by him about his suit in this behalf expended and the said defendant in mercy &c.

On the motion of Thomas Francis a witness for James Brooks at the suit of Thomas Talon ord^d that the said Brooks pay him fifty pounds of Tobacco for two days attendance on this court according to law.
