This day came the p^{ty} by his attorney the deft being duly summoned and serv'd with a copy of the petition and not appearing on the motion of the p^{ty} by his attorney. It is considered by the Court that the p^{ty} recover agst the said deft the said one pound sixteen shillings and five pence $\frac{1}{2}$ together with int^r from the 3^d April 1763 till paid.
