6 This day came the parties by their attys and the defendant withdrawing his former plea saith he cannot gainsay the pif's action nor but that he doth owe the debt in the declaration mentioned Therefore it is consider'd by the Court that the pif recover agst the said defendant one hundred and fifty pounds three shillings and five pence and his costs by him about his suit in this behalf expended and the said deft in mercy &c But this judgment except as to the cost is to be discharged by the payment of £155. 3. 5⁰ together with interest from the 19th May 1702 till paid
