

chose Arthur Foster for his guardian whereupon the said Arthur together with Benjamin Turner his security entered into and acknowledged his bond in the penalty of £500 for the said Arthur securing the said orphans estate and indemnifying the court.

Benjamin Turner is by the court appointed guardian to Thomas Turner orphan of Simon Turner deceased whereupon the said Benjamin together with Arthur Foster his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of £1000 for the said Benjamin Turners due and faithful guardianship of the said orphans estate and indemnifying the court.

A report concerning nottway swamp bridge was this day made and is in the words following to wit: In obedience to an order of Southampton court bearing date 12 day of November 1767 to us Albrigton Jones, Henry Briggs and Thomas Butts directed to let the building a bridge over nottway swamp below Jones mill where the old bridge stood we did meet at the place aforesaid the 17 day of the said month November and did then settle the building of the same to Henry Briggs for the sum of five pounds nine shillings which we certify we do further certify that at the request of Henry Briggs we have viewed the said bridge built by him and find it built and completed according to agreement given under our hands this 13th Janry 1768.

Whereupon It is Ordered that the Treasurer pay unto the said Henry Briggs the said five pounds nine shillings.

An indenture of feoffment between Arthur Arrington of the one part and Peter Butts of the other part was proved by the oath of Thomas Clements Butts the same having been heretofore proved by two other witnesses and ordered to be recorded.

An indenture of feoffment between Arthur Arrington of the one part and Anne Pearce of the other part and a memorandum of livery of seison thereon endorsed were proved by the oaths of Thomas Chappell James Arrington and John Adams three of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded And Mary the wife of the said Arthur personally appeared in court and being first privately examined as the law directs voluntarily relinquished her right of dower in the estate conveyed by the said indenture.
