Upon the petition of John Ony against William Bryant for one pound fifteen shillings due by account This day came the parties by their attorneys who being fully heard It is considered by the court that the said petition be dismissed

Upon the petition of Simon Harris ^{exr William Lankford} against George Collier for one pound nine shillings and two pence and interest due by account This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and the defendant being solemnly called and not appearing On the Motion of the said plaintiff who proved his demand to be just by his own oath It is considered by the court that he recover against the said defendant the said one pound nine shillings and two pence together with interest for the same to be computed after the rate of five per centum per annum from the 14th day of January 1768 till paid and his costs by him in this behalf expended

Upon the petition of Nathaniel Pittman against Jonathan Brown for three pounds ten shillings due by account This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and the defendant being solemnly called and not appearing On the Motion of the said plaintiff who proved his demand to be just by his own oath It is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the said three pounds ten shillings and his costs by him in this behalf expended

This day came as well the plaintiff by his attorney as the defendant in his proper person who confessed the plaintiffs action for six pounds fourteen shillings the debt in the declaration mentioned Therefore On the Motion of the said plaintiff It is considered by the court that he recover against the said defendant the said six pounds fourteen shillings and his costs by him about his suit in this behalf expended and the said defendant in mercy &c But this judgment except as to the costs is to be discharged by the payment of three pounds seven shillings together with interest for the same to be computed after the rate of five per centum per annum from the 11th day of July 1766 to the time of payment
