said plaintiff It is considered by the court that he recover against the
said Arthur the said seven pounds eight hundred and twenty one pounds
of nut tobacco and fifteen shillings and his costs by him in this
behalf expended And It is Ordered that the said garnishee pay
this judgment and costs

An indenture of scoffment between Josiah Johnson of the one
part and Francis Mills of the of the other part was acknowledged
by the said Josiah Johnson and ordered to be recorded And
Temperance the wife of the said Josiah personally appeared in
court and being first privately examined as the law directs
voluntarily relinquished her right of dower conveyed
by the said indenture

note This day Came the parties by their attorneys atts
being fully heard It is considered by the court
that the plaintiff recover agst the said defendant
the said four pounds and his costs by him in this
