Upon the petition of Joshua Gros against Matthew Jones admors of Joseph Denson decd for four pounds ten shillings due by account This day came the parties by their attorney who being fully heard It is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the said four pounds ten shillings & his costs by him this behalf expended. And that the plaintiff acknowledges satisfaction for four pounds eleven ^{shillings} and four pence half penny paid in discharge of this judgment & costs
