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attorney as the defendant in his proper person who confessed the
plaintiff's action for thirteen pounds eight shillings the debt in the
declaration mentioned. Therefore It is considered by the court that the
plaintiff recover against the said defendant the said thirteen pounds
eight shillings and his costs by him about his suit in this behalf
expended and the said defendant in money. But this judgment
except as to the costs is to be discharged by the payment of four
pounds fifteen shillings and two pence together with interest
for the same to be computed after the rate of five per centum
per annum from the 12th day of March 1767 to the time of
payment.

Upon the petition of Mads Jones adm^r of Joseph Brown
agst James Speed for one pound nine shillings eleven
pence and interest due by account. This day came as well
the plaintiff by Edward Fisher his attorney as the defendant
in his proper person who faith that he cannot
gain say the allegation of the said petition. Therefore
It is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover
against the said defendant the said one pound nine
shillings and eleven pence and interest for the same from
the 20 day of April 1766 till paid and his costs by him in
this behalf expended.

Richard Kelle came into court and undertook
for the defendants that in case they should be cast in this
suit they shall pay the condemnation of the court or
render their bodies to prison in discharge of the same or
that he the said Richard would do it for them to wit upon
the said defendants by Richard Baker their attorney saving
to themselves all advantage of exception as well the
plaintiffs suit as to the declaration prayer and have leave
to impeach till the next court.

An indenture of feoffment between Joseph Sells of the one
part and Horrell Edmunds of the other part and a
memorandum of livery of seisin and receipt thereon entered
were acknowledged by the said Joseph Sells and ordered to
be recorded.
