 Ruffin his attorney as the defendant in his proper person
 who confesseth the plaintiffs action for five pounds —
 fourteen shillings and nine pence the debt in the
 declaration mentioned Therefore It is considered by the court
 that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the five pounds
 fourteen shillings and nine pence and his costs by him about
 his suit in this behalf expended and the said defendant in-
 murey &c. But this judgment except as to the costs is to be —
 discharged by the payment of two pounds seventeen shillings
 and four pence half penny together with interest for the same
 to be computed after the rate of five per centum per annum
 from the eleventh day of September 1760 to the time of payment

 plaintiffs action for twelve pounds the debt in the declaration mentioned

 costs by him about his suit in this behalf expended and the
 said defendant in murey &c. But this judgment except as to
 the costs is to be discharged by the payment of six pounds
 together with interest for the same to be computed after
 the rate of five per centum per annum from the seventeenth
 day of March 1767 to the time of payment
