This day came as well the plaintiff by Edward Fisher his attorney as the defendants in their proper person who confessed the allegation of the said petition to be true. Therefore It is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendants the said three pounds two shillings and eleven pence and interest from the 9 day of April 1767 till paid and his costs by him in this behalf expended.

The petition of Elizabeth Long and Jemmy Long execs of Arthur Long dec^d against John Avery Es^r Ordered to abate the said bill being returned no inhabitant.

Upon the petition of James Day Ridley against Jacob Newson for two pounds two shillings and three pence due by account. This day came ^{as well} the plaintiff by Daniel Fisher his attorney, as the defendant in his proper person who saith that he cannot gainsay the allegation of the said petition. Therefore It is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the said two pounds two shillings & three pence and his costs by him in this behalf expended. And that the plaintiff request stay execution upon this judgment till next court.
