And that the plaintiff agrees to stay execution upon this judgment one month from this time.

Ordered that the sheriff summon twenty four of the most capable persons of this county not being ordinary keepers constables surveyors of highways or owners or occupiers of a mill to appear at the court house on the second Thursday in May next and be sworn a grand jury of inquest on the body of this county.

On the Motion of Isaac Poffe a witness for Hollomell Denson at the suit of Simon Banck. It is Ordered that the said Denson pay him twenty five pounds of rest to have for one days attendance on this court.
