Ordered that the several and respective persons do take the list of tithables as last year and in the same precincts except Joseph Gray in the room of Charles Cosby and Thomas Williamson in the room of Joseph Gray

Upon the petition of William Pope It is Ordered that he be exempted from payment of lvy in this county

Ordered that the churchwardens of the parish of saint Luke bind out William Gurby orphan of Nicholas Gurby dead according to law

A deed poll from Richard Thiby to Benjamin Thiby was acknowledged by the said Richard & ordered to be recorded

An indenture of feoffment between Henry Pope & Mary his wife of the one part and William Wilson of the other and a receipt thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the said Henry and ordered to be recorded

An inventory and appraisement of the estate of James Powell dead was returned & ordered to be recorded

Upon the petition of James Wright It is Ordered that he be exempted from payment of lvy in this county

Ordered that Cordell Nesbit John Blunt and William Blunt or any two of them do examine the & settle Nathan Francis account of his portion of John Francis's estate & make report there of to the next

An indenture of feoffment between Thomas Chapfule of the one part and William Anderson and Elizabeth his wife of the other part was acknowledged by the said Thomas Chapfule & ordered to be recorded

An indenture of feoffment between David Edmunds of the one part and Benjamin Turner of the other part and a receipt thereon endorsed were proved by the oaths of
