An indenture of feoffment between John Borch of the one part and Cordal Noyslet of the other part and was proved by the oaths of Stephen Williamson & Britain Jones two of the witnesses thereto

Nancy Foster orphan of Elias Foster died this day in court chose Thomas Day for her guardian whereupon the said Thomas together with Thomas Day jr his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of one hundred pounds for the said Thomas (Day) due and faithful guardianship of the said orphan estate and indemnifying the court Elizabeth Long & Quary Longeons of Arthur Long decd

Sept Jones Dep In Debt

Britain Jones came into court and undertook for the defendant that in case he shall be cast in this suit he shall pay the condemnation of the court or render his body to prison in discharge of the same or that he said Britain will do it for him whereupon the said Sept Jones confessed the plaintiffs action for twenty pounds the sum in the declaration mentioned Therefore It is considered by the court that the plaintiffs recover against the said defendant the said twenty pounds and their costs by them about their suit in this behalf expended and the said defendant in mercy &c But this judgment except as to the costs is to be discharged by the payment of eight pounds and two pence together with interest for the same to be computed after the rate of five per centum per annum from the 26 day of June 1766 to the time of payment
